



## Lizzy's diary, january, 1899

 "I am thinking often about death and the end of all things. It's silly that also I, now so strong and healthy, ever shall be gone, A handful of ash, as if I never had existed. I hope my end is not that near. Because the way I have to go lies still in front of me. Something of me has to keep alive. In fact that's why I'm writing now.

Lizzy became a lawyer in 1903




## Lizzy's Diary in 1897


## Lizzy's diary, august 1899

- "I am so happy that I began to study.
   Therefore my whole life is different to me.
   I am free, I can give my whole life for learning. [...]"
- "But sometimes, when I am lonely, I think that I was not made to stay alone. [...] But if I would marry I should get a really shining position, because I am not made to be only a modest housewife." Invnr 377





## Appraisal and Selection
